Private Well Permit

This permit has been issued to _____ at _____, Muscodia, WI on _____.

It shall be granted to the above mentioned well owner, who may, with this permit, operate a private well for a period not to exceed five years, at which time two safe water samples will need to be submitted with a renewal application.

The following requirements must be met to receive this permit per Village Code of Ordinance 8-1-8(e); Well Operation Permit. Owners of wells on premises served by the municipal water system wishing to retain their well for any use shall make application for a well operation permit for each well no later than ninety (90) days after connection to the municipal water system. The Village of Muscodia shall grant a permit to a well owner to operate a well for a period not to exceed five (5) years providing all conditions of this Section are met. A well operation permit may be renewed by submitting an application verifying that the conditions of this Section are met. The Village of Muscodia, or its agents, may conduct inspections and water quality tests to be conducted at the applicant's expense to obtain or verify information necessary for consideration of a permit application or renewal. Permit applications and renewals shall be made on forms provided by the Village of Muscodia. All initial and renewal applications must be accompanied by a fee of \$100. The following conditions must be met before issuance or renewal of a well operation permit:

- (1) The well and pump installation shall meet the "Standards for Existing Installations" describe in NR 812.42, Wisconsin Administration Code.
- (2) The well and pump shall have a history of producing safe water evidenced by at least two coliform bacteria samples taken a minimum of two weeks apart. In areas where the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources has determined that groundwater aquifers are contaminated with substances other than bacteria, additional chemical test may be required to document the safety of the water.
- (3) There shall be no cross-connections between the well's pump installation or distribution piping and the municipal water system.
- (4) The water from the private well shall not discharge into a drain leading directly to a public sewer utility unless properly metered and authorized by the sewer utility.
- (5) The private well shall have a functional pumping system.
- (6) The proposed use of the private well shall be justified as reasonable in addition to water provided by the municipal water system.

Any well owner violating any provision of this Section shall upon conviction by punished by forfeiture of not less that Two Hundred fifty Dollars (\$250.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and the cost of prosecution. Each day of violation is a separate offense. If any person fails to comply with this Section for more than thirty (30) days after receiving written notice of the violation, the Village may impose a penalty and cause the well abandonment to be performed and the expense to be assessed as a special tax against the property.
